Duty to Report

There are certain situations under the mental health professionals. They are requested by law and ethical code to reveal information obtained during meetings/ sessions with Disability Services to other persons or agencies without the client's permission. These are as follows:

- 1. If the student threatens bodily harm or death to another person.
- 2. If the student threatens bodily harm or death to themselves.
- 3. If the student reveals information about known or suspected physical/ sexual abuse or neglect of a minor child, a developmentally disabled adult, or an elderly adult dependent on special care.
- 4. A direct Court Order.
