

### ALABAMA STATE UNIVERSITY BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING DUNN-OLIVER ACADOME BOARD ROOM FEBRUARY 8, 2013

### **MINUTES**

### I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Alabama State University Board of Trustees was called to order at 2.30 P.M. by Chairman Elton N. Dean in the Dunn-Oliver Acadome.

### II. INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Henry Davis, Executive Director of Public Safety at Alabama State University.

### III. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The pledge of allegiance was recited by all.

### IV. ESTABLISHMENT OF QUORUM

Upon voice roll call by President Harris, a quorum was affirmed. Those trustees present were Trustee Elton Dean, Marvin Wiggins, Locy Baker, Buford Crutcher, Taylor Hodge, Alfreda Green and Jacqueline Brooks. Trustees Thomas Figures, Bobby Junkins, Thomas Figures and Herbert Young were absent.

### V. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Trustee Wiggins moved, seconded by Trustee Hodge, to adopt the agenda. The motion was adopted by unanimous vote.

### VI. ADOPTION OF MINUTES - JANUARY 24, 2013

Trustee Wiggins moved, seconded by Trustee Hodge, to approve the minutes of January 24, 2013. The minutes were unanimously approved.

### VII. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President Harris stated that his report would come through the various reports of the standing committees from the meetings held on January 21, 2013.

### VIII. COMMITTEE REPORTS

### A. ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

Trustee Hodge, chair of the Academic Affairs Committee stated that the Committee met on January 21, 2013 and no action was taken. He then asked Dr. Leon Wilson, Interim Provost/Vice President for Academic Affairs, to continue with the report from the committee meeting.

Dr. Wilson said that the Academic Affairs unit was charged with the responsibility of updating the Board on various components of the academic affairs unit. He introduced Dr. Christine Thomas, Director of the Office of Planning and Evaluation, to give a brief presentation on the progress that the university has been making in the area of program viability. Dr. Thomas reported that the primary purpose of the academic program review is to determine the sustainability and quality of all of the university's academic offerings. Currently, seventy percent of all the university's programs have been reviewed. Continuing, she said that the ongoing nature of this academic review will place the University in a positive position for its 5th Year Interim Report which is due to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges in 2016.

Concluding the academic affairs report, Dr. Wilson extended congratulations to Dr. Mishra, who recently received an award for his cancer research.

### **B. STUDENT AFFAIRS COMMITTEE**

Trustee Marvin Wiggins, Chair of the Student Affairs Committee reported that there were no action items addressed at the meeting held on January 21, 2013.

### C. FINANCE COMMITTEE

In the absence of Trustee Herbert Young, Chair of the Finance Committee, Chairman Dean reported that there were no action items from the January 21, 2013 meeting of the Finance Committee.

President Harris brought to the attention of the Board, the investment report from Synovous Trust Company for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2012. The referenced report was distributed to all members of the board for their perusal.

### E. AUDIT COMMITTEE

Trustee Green, Chairlady of the Audit Committee, reported that the committee met on January 21, 2103. There were no action items.

The Athletics Committee met on January 21, 2013. Trustee Baker, chair of the committee, reported that no action was taken.

### X. FACULTY SENATE REPORT

Mr. Charlie Hardy, Chair of the Faculty Senate gave a very brief report. His major point of concern was the matter of shared governance as it relates to having faculty senate representation on the Presidential Search Committee. He expressed a desire to have a faculty senate representative on the Search Committee. Secondly, Mr. Hardy mentioned that he had spoken with the Provost about some concerns that have been registered with the Faculty Senate about the College of Education.

### XI. NON-INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF REPORT

The report of the Non-Instructional Staff Council (NISC) was made by Mrs. Georgette Varner. She reported that the NISC sponsored the University-Wide Annual Memorial Service on November 15, 2012, in the Ralph D. Abernathy Auditorium with Mr. Cromwell Handy, Director of Alumni Relations, as the speaker. Additionally, during the 2012 homecoming week the NISC hosted the first faculty and staff talent show with great participation from faculty and staff. Many staff members were a part of the successful opening of the new ASU Stadium during the 2012 Turkey Day Classic. Lastly, the NISC is asking all employees to get more involved by becoming mentors to students, attending ASU events and providing overall support of the University.

### XII. STUDENT GOVERNMENT REPORT

Mr. Kyle Burney reported that the SGA senate is now functioning. SGA interest meetings were held this week. Mr. Burney attended the annual meeting of the National Association for Student Affairs professionals with Vice President William Hytche and is now a member of this organization. Other SGA matters are ongoing as reported in previous meetings.

### XIV. OTHER BUSINESS

Trustee Baker, Chair of the Athletics Committee, raised some concerns about the vacant positions in Athletics and the academic progress report for various sports.

President Harris replied that the Interim Athletic Director should provide the information in question to the administration so that it can be appropriately discussed during the Athletic Committee meeting and then forwarded to the full Board if action is required.

### XV. ADJOURNMENT

Trustee Wiggins moved to recess the meeting until the call of the chair. Trustee Hodge seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. The meeting recessed at 2:51 p.m.
