Return to Play Plan: Key Points

- Preparation before returning to campus/Athletic Facilities
 - Self Quarantine
 - Monitoring of Contacts 14 days prior
 - Those traveling from Level 3 countries will have to quarantine for 14 days
 - Fever Free during "home" quarantine period without the use of medicine
 - No Symptoms of COVID-19 during the "home" quarantine period
- Return to Campus/Exercise
 - All student athletes will be tested for COVID-19 upon their return to campus
 - Temperature checks will occur daily
 - Health education sessions (conducted by Student Health)
 - App to monitor wellness/symptoms (this will be university-wide)
 - Specific bubbling for student-athletes who may have similar medical conditions
 - Limited amount of student-athletes in weight room facilities to accommodate social distancing measures

Return to Play Plan: Key Points (continued)

- Facility Preparedness
 - Limited Access and designated entry and exit points
 - Sanitation stations, wipes, hand sanitizer readily available
 - Mask Mandatory
 - Social Distancing
 - Frequent reminders throughout Athletic facilities to "Know Your Ws"
 - Disinfect "high touch" areas multiple times of the day
 - Fogging/Deep cleaning of all Athletic Facilities in the evening
- Additional Items
 - Increased access for Mental Health care services for student-athletes
 - Team travel limited to essential personnel only
 - Increased emphasis on PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY of all student-athletes during the pandemic



COVID-19 Football Season Ticket Refund Policy

Highlights:

- Three options if games or season is cancelled
 - Donate funds to the Hornet Club
 - Apply an account credit towards the 2021 football season
 - Receive a refund for tickets, prorated or full
- Renewal Deadline extended to July 31, 2020
- Payment Plan Option available this year (allows for payments to be spread through August 31,2020)
- Single Game Tickets On Sale—August 3, 2020
- No day of game ticket purchases—only digital on game day

Proposed Game Day Adjustments

- Reduced Fan Capacity (inclusive of Club lounge, suites, and terrace)
- Mask Mandatory Facility
- Social Distancing Required
- Temperature Checks upon entry
- Designated Entry Points
- No Tailgating or RVs for the 2020 football season
- Use of external production team for streaming all home games, with high quality viewing for fans
- Limited Sideline/Press Box Access
- Limited Amount of Tickets given to visiting teams

Proposed Game Day Adjustments

- No visiting bands allowed
- Mighty Marching Hornets will perform from the stands
- Mighty Marching Hornets will sit on the visiting team side (where the visiting bands would normally sit)
- Student section will also encompass the end zone
- Cashless Facility and Parking (credit cards and/or digital pay only)
- No day of game ticket purchases--Digital Tickets will be strongly encouraged
- Highschool pass will not be accepted this year
- Athletic Staff Tickets, University Leadership, complimentary tickets, etc. will be reduced this year



Certification Audit

- After further discussion with our consultant regarding the certification audit it was recommended that we provide written responses to Buckner's questions in the audit and share that information with the NCAA
- The responses were submitted the first week of April
- On May 20, 2020 we received official word from Angie Cretors associate at the Compliance Group, stating that "the (NCAA) enforcement staff indicated that they will not be moving forward with any review of Mr. Buckner's audit report."



Probation Status

- Our Senior Associate AD for Internal Operations has worked directly with The Compliance Group to compile all information needed to remove us from probation, and restore us to our full membership status from an Infractions case that occurred in 2012
- The Compliance Group submitted the second draft of the packet of information to send to the NCAA early this month
- We are currently reviewing the information and plan to submit to the NCAA before the month is out



Academic Progress Rate (APR)

- What is APR?
 - An academic based metric used to hold institutions accountable for the academic progress of their student-athletes
 - Accounts for the eligibility and retention of each student-athlete for each academic term



APR is calculated as follows:

- Each student-athlete receiving athletic aid earns one point for staying in school and one point for being academically eligible
- A team's total points are divided by points possible and then multiplied by 1000 to equal the team's APR
- In addition to a team's current-year APR, its rolling four year APR is also used to determine accountability
- Reporting for APR is done using a tax model (i.e. data is from the previous year)
 - Teams must earn a four year average APR of 930 to compete in championships

 Men's Basketball suffered rapid declines in its single year APR scores beginning with the 2014-15 roster

APR—Moving Forward (Next Steps)

- Strong emphasis on restructuring key units within the internal units in the department, by replacing certain personnel and increasing staffing in the areas of Compliance and Academics
- A comprehensive committee was formed to create an academic improvement plan for the men's basketball program
 - This plan was submitted and accepted by the NCAA
- This committee is committed to the revitalization of our Men's Basketball program's APR status for the long term, and will continue to educate and implement the necessary actions in efforts to avoid significant declines in any of our programs moving forward
